





UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

- College students who meet specific requirements you will receive early review of your academic records, early admission notification and specific guidance about major preparation and general education coursework.
- **To be eligible for a <u>UC Tag**</u> you must have the following:
 - 30 completed <u>UC units</u>
 - Meet GPA requirement
 - Major specific and preparation
 - Only one UC TAG application can be completed with the following 6 UCs:



No TAGS with UCLA, UC Berkeley, and UC San Diego.



Transfer Application Deadlines

- University of California TAG: September 1 September 30
- California State University: **October 1 November 30**
- University of California: November 1 November 30
- No exceptions!
- UC will NOT accept Spring transfers
- Some CSU campuses will accept Spring transfers

Application deadlines for private universities
& out of state schools will vary.
