Parking Information:

Soccer: Visiting buses can park next to the fields. Fans and vans should park in Lot Q. Parking is \$1.00

Baseball: Visiting buses can park next to the fields. Fans and vans should park in Lot Q. Parking is \$1.00

Basketball, Volleyball and Softball: Lots K and L. Parking is \$1.00

Tennis: Lots K, L, F and S

We will only send parking passes to visiting teams upon request. You do not need a pass if you are driving a state vehicle, van or bus.

Training Room:

The field house training room is located northeast corner of Ratcliffe Stadium utilized by the Baseball, Football, Soccer, and Track and Field teams.

The gym training room is located in the concourse directly in front of the gymnasium. This facility is utilized by the Badminton, Basketball, Softball, Tennis, Volleyball, Water Polo, and Wrestling teams.

Locker Rooms:

The locker rooms for athletics are located at both sites. The Ratcliffe site is on the northeast corner of the stadium, and the gymnasium site is located across from the main gym. The teams utilizing these facility are the same as listed with the above training room sites.

Athlete Decorum:

The CCCAA rules are used to regulated athlete behavior. The coach and on-site administrator of the event will monitor and regulate athlete behavior to insure that the standards of decorum are met.

CCCAA Decorum Statement:

The CCCAA (California Community College Athletics Association) Decorum policy is in effect at any Community College athletic event, which is sanctioned by the state office. Please be respectful and courteous to each other.

The CCCAA strongly encourages all participants and fans to avoid using profane language, taunting opponents and fans, or making inappropriate gestures or non-verbal signs to opposing teams, players, and fans.

In addition, any non-credentialed person that comes into the playing surface will be immediately escorted out of the venue by security.

Those violating the CCCAA decorum policy will be warned and any continued violations will result in ejection from the venue.
