



Student Equity at FCC



Student Equity at FCC is not solely viewed as a regulatory requirement.

Instead, Student Equity is viewed as an opportunity to bring awareness to the root causes and effects of inequities to provide faculty, classified professionals, and administrators with the information and resources necessary to mitigate outcome disparities.

Background

1/14/17: Chancellor's Office releases 2016-17 expenditure guidelines for BSI, SE, and SSSP

1/15/17: Chancellor's Office requires colleges to integrate BSI, SE, and SSSP into one cohesive plan, and releases Integrated Plan template

Intent: Decreasing the duplication of efforts while improving coordination across the three programs to increase student success and close equity gaps.

Compliance: The three programs retain separate requirements as specified in Education Code and title 5 regulations; requirements are built into the Integrated Plan to ensure compliance with applicable law and regulations

BSI, SE, SSSP Integrated Plan Template

- 2-Year Plan
- **12 questions** with specific word limits for most questions, including:
 - Previous accomplishments
 - Progress towards achieving the identified goals from prior year plans
 - Integrated student success goals and integrated budget plan for 2017-19
- Required to select 5 overarching (integrated) goals
- Required to create an executive summary
- FCC decided to use Student Equity as the overarching driver of the Integrated Plan goals and activities in an effort to imbed Student Equity at FCC

Equity in Student Success Outcome

Challenges

- Internal bureaucratic practices
- Circumstantial challenges: Ability to hire key leadership roles necessary to advance equity and implement changes to old programs has contributed to stalled efforts
- Decreasing equity gaps takes time = Educational inequity is a multifaceted and systemic problem

Reflecting on the results. . .

- Through campus based research, inquiry, and reflection, FCC has come to the conclusion that this is the result of an overreliance on unscalable, small, programmatic approaches to closing equity gaps.
- To that end, the college is currently engaged in several <u>college wide</u> projects and activities specifically designed to increase success and completion amongst students of color.
