Notes:

1. The Pre-Allied Health degree offers an interdisciplinary approach of study for students seeking to enter the profession of health care in a variety of ways. The degree will allow students to pursue a rigorous course of study before selecting in an area of concentration to match their career and study interests. With emphasis on basic science, cultural competence in healthcare, the degree offered will prepare students to pursue Allied Health and Nursing programs.
2. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
3. The *Associate Degree* requires completion of the major (38 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Associate Degree requirements – basic competencies, physical education/Dance, and lifetime physical and mental wellness – and General Education requirements for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA. Additional courses may be needed to meet the minimum of 60 units required to obtain an Associate of Science Degree.
4. Math 103 can be substituted with a higher level math course, for example Math 3A or Math 11. Please see a counselor.
5. Some of the courses are program prerequisites for Allied Health and Nursing Programs at Fresno City College.
6. It is recommended that students complete AHLTH 100 during their first semester.
