**Notes:**

1. The Spanish Program is designed to prepare students for entry into a variety of career options requiring intermediate or better levels of fluency. The Spanish major also acquaints students with the cultures of Spanish speaking countries.

3. Two Spanish courses can be used to fulfill the area "C", General Education requirement in Humanities for graduation or two courses for CSU transfer.
4. Two of the following courses may be challenged according to Foreign Language Department policy: SPAN 1, 2.

The *Associate Degree* requires completion of the major (22 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Associate Degree requirements – basic competencies, physical education/Dance, and lifetime physical and mental wellness – and General Education requirements for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
