2. The unit from HONORS 1F can **NOT** be used toward admission to any UC campus; evaluation of colloquium

courses completed by individual UC campus **AFTER** admission.

3. This program is not an admission requirement for transfer to 4-year universities/colleges.
4. Students transferring to a UC/CSU in a high unit major must see a FCC honors advisor before completing general education courses.
5. * An exception can be made if the student has successfully completed ENGL 1A prior to entering the Honors program.
