- Students planning to transfer to CSU Fresno in Business Administration should refer to the CSU Fresno Business Administration major sheet for important major and CSU GE planning information.
- This major contains most of the lower division requirements for CSU Fresno's BS degree in Business Administration. It is available, together with required CSU GE courses, in a one-course-per-month format designed for students who have full time day jobs and are interested in an accelerated program leading to transfer to CSU Fresno in Business Administration as well as in a traditional format. - BA 10 and BA 20 transfer to CSU or UC as an elective. All other courses meet Fresno State's lower division major and/or general education requirements.
- Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
- The Associate Degree requires completion of the major (33 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course. Students must complete one of the three different general education patterns: option 1 – Fresno City College General Education, option 2 – CSU GE Breadth– California State University General Education, OR option 3 – IGETC – Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
- This program will be deleted from curriculum effective SPRING 2022.
