**Notes:**

1. The Theatre Arts major is a more *performance* oriented major emphasizing a "hands on" approach and places special focus on the "well rounded" theatre artist. Students who complete the program can successfully transfer to a competitive four-year university or conservatory. 3. The *Associate Degree* requires completion of the major (24 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course. Students must complete one of the three different general education patterns: option 1 – Fresno City College General Education, option 2 – CSU GE Breadth– California State University General Education, OR option 3 – IGETC – Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
