1. The Associate in Arts in Art History for Transfer Degree offers a core foundation for the study of art history across cultures and eras. The program prepares students to continue their studies towards a degree in art history or studio arts at the California State University (CSU) and the University of California (UC) systems. Students will learn skills of analyzing art within its historical and cultural context using art-specific terminology and methodologies.
