- 1. A Leon S. Peters Certificate will be awarded to Honors students who successfully complete a minimum of 15 credits of Honors courses including 1 colloquium units with an overall GPA of 3.2 or better. Certificates do not appear on the transcript.
- 2. The unit from HONORS 1F can **NOT** be used toward admission to any UC campus; evaluation of colloquium courses completed by individual UC campus **AFTER** admission.
- 3. This program is not an admission requirement for transfer to 4-year universities/colleges.
- 4. Students transferring to a UC/CSU in a high unit major must see a FCC honors advisor before completing general education courses.
- 5. \* An exception can be made if the student has successfully completed ENGL 1A prior to entering the Honors program.
