## Notes:

- 1. The Associate of Arts in ASL/English Interpreting prepares students to transfer to a four-year institution in order to earn a bachelors degree required to become a certified interpreter. Specifically, students will develop foundational skills needed to gain language fluency, manage complex cognitive tasks, and convey a dynamically equivalent message between ASL and English.
- 2. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
- 3. The Associate Degree requires the completion of the major (23 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course. Students must complete one of the three different general education patterns: option 1 Fresno City College General Education, option 2 CSU GE Breadth– California State University General Education, OR option 3 IGETC Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
