## Notes:

- This program is designed to provide the student with updated skills and knowledge necessary to complete and successfully apply for fire service careers. The curriculum serves as an in-service program as well as a preemployment program for students seeking employment or advancement in the profession of firefighting and technology.
- 2. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
- 3. Students should plan to take most of their Associate degree and GE requirements in the Fall semesters.
- 4. It is recommended that students establish eligibility for ENGL 125 and 126 or EMLS 167 and 168.
- 5. \*FIRET 130A and 130B carries a value of up to 14.5 units; however, only 6 units can be applied to the A.S. Degree.
- 6. The Associate Degree requires completion of the major (23-33.5 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course. Students must complete one of the three different general education patterns: option 1 Fresno City College General Education, option 2 CSU GE Breadth– California State University General Education, OR option 3 IGETC Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
