Notes:

- Music majors should enroll in Music Theory and Ear Training each semester. Students should begin the course sequence starting in first fall semester enrolled. (Music Theory: MUS 1A or 1AE/1B/2A/2B; Ear Training: MUS 7A/7B/7C/7D.)
- Music majors should enroll in Applied Music each semester. Students should select the appropriate Intermediate/Advanced or Applied Music Masterclass and Lessons course based on their chosen performance specialty. (ex. brass, guitar, percussion, piano, strings, voice, woodwind)
- 3. Music majors should enroll in an Ensemble each semester. (ex. band, choir, jazz combo, orchestra)
