- 1. This certificate is designed for students interested in working in the field of substance use disorders. Completion of the total certificate of achievement will broaden a candidate's understanding and assist in preparation needed to enter the field. This certificate is accredited by the California Association for Alcohol/Drug Educators (CAADE) and recognized by the other certifying organizations in California. The Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counseling Certificate program offers course work leading to a certificate of achievement and an AS degree in Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counseling.

- **HS 42 is a prerequisite to HS 43, and HS 43 is a prerequisite to HS 19B. The courses must be taken in that order (42, 43, 19B) and may not be taken concurrently.
- 4. The Certificate of Achievement requires completion of the major (37-38 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course.
