Notes:

1. All students interested in a music major should read the catalog and consult with music faculty and a counselor as soon as possible.
2. Music majors should enroll in Music Theory and Ear Training each semester. Students should begin the course sequence starting in first fall semester enrolled. (Music Theory: MUS 1A or 1AE/1B/2A/2B; Ear Training: MUS 7A/7B/7C/7D.). LIST A courses MUS 2B and MUS 7D highly recommended for most universities.
3. Music majors should enroll in Applied Music each semester. Students should select the appropriate Intermediate/Advanced or Applied Music Masterclass and Lessons course based on their chosen performance specialty. (ex. brass, guitar, percussion, piano, strings, voice, woodwind)
4. Some universities (Fresno State) require proficiency in Piano regardless of Music Major Emphasis. Consult with your counselor to determine if or when you should register for MUS 20 (Beginning Piano: Level I) or MUS 21 (Beginning Piano: Level II).
5. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
6. The *Associate Degree for Transfer* requires completion of the major (23-24 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Education requirements (either CSU GE Breadth or IGETC CSU) for a total of **60 CSU-transferable semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
