When a Veteran is certified for the first time, **the process time may take 8-12 weeks.**
PLEASE FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW TO START YOUR BENEFITS AT FCC.

A. Applying to FCC:

First: Become a Student

- Applied to FCC: At www.fresnocitycollege.edu. Two days later you will be emailed a student I.D. number.
- Complete Online Orientation: At www.fresnocitycollege.edu to create a Web Advisor, Blackboard, and Student Email account.
- Financial Aid (Optional): At www.fafsa.ed.gov The Board Of Governors Grant (BOGG) Fee Waiver is recommended.

N/A B. English & Math Placement Test: **Optional** If Math and English classes have been completed at any prior college.

-Upcoming test & locations can be found in the Assessment Center portal at www.fresnocitycollege.edu

N/A C. Prior College Credit Evaluation:

- Transcripts from all prior colleges must be turned in before the veteran may be seen by a counselor.
- Unofficial transcripts can be used to move on to step 3, while awaiting for the official transcripts to arrive.

Official Transcripts Ordered: From your previous college mailed to your home. Please bring a **sealed copy** into the FCC VRC, we will keep a copy, and turn in the original into Admissions Office.

Second: Process Your Education Benefits

Step 1: Apply & Complete a Military Credit Evaluation (MCE)

Contact Form Completed

Applying to the V.A.: Apply on-line at www.gibill.va.gov and fill out Form 22-1990 (Application for Educational Benefits).

-2 to 8 weeks after applying you will receive a **Letter of Eligibility** in the mail.

Letter of Eligibility / N/A Veterans Form 1995: If attended and used benefits at a previous college

Military Credit Evaluation (MCE) in File:

Petition: The petition allows us to process your MCE.

DD-214 Member 4: A **DD-214 Member 4 Copy**. If you have more than 1 DD-214 (National Guard/ Reserve, or served multiple non-consecutive terms), **please bring in all of them.**

Joint Service Transcripts / CCAF: Can access your **unofficial** JST's at <https://jst.doded.mil/smart/signIn.do>

MCE Submitted: **MCE takes about 2 weeks to be completed.** Air Force: <http://www.au.af.mil/au/ccaf/>

Step 2: Student Education Plan (SEP)

-The SEP is developed by the veterans' counselor and the student.

-The Veterans' Counselor will also evaluate the student's prior college transcripts to determine which credits will transfer to FCC.

-The SEP is a list of all the classes that the Veterans' Dependents must attend to obtain their educational goal.

Step 3: Certification

Registration: After receiving your SEP from the Veterans' Counselor, your next step is to register for classes on your [Web Advisor](#) using your SEP as a list. Keep in mind *****The V.A. will not pay for classes not on your SEP*****

Official Schedule from Admissions Office: After you register for your classes you must bring a copy of your **official schedule** from the **admissions office only**. *****Not from Web Advisor***.**

Control Card: To be completed in the Veterans Office *****Before the Beginning of Every Semester*****. This card is signed by the veteran to give authorization for the Veterans' Certifying Official to certify you for your education benefits with the V.A **SO YOU CAN GET PAID ON TIME.**

*****You will be certified for your benefits ONLY after ALL documents have been submitted to the FCC VRC*****
