First: Become a Student

	<u>Financial Aid (Optional)</u> : At <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u> The Board Of Governors Grant (BOGG) Fee Waiver is

_	A <u>English & Math Placement Test:</u> Optional If Math and English classes have been completed at prior collegesUpcoming test & locations can be found in the Assessment Center portal at www.fresnocitycollege.edu
	A Prior College Credit Evaluation:
	-Transcripts from all prior colleges must be turned in before the veteran may be seen by a counselor.
	-Unofficial transcripts can be used to move to step 3 while waiting for the arrival of the official]Unofficial Transcripts in File
	Official Transcripts Ordered: From your previous college mailed to your home. Please bring a sealed copy into
	the FCC VRC, we will keep a copy, and turn in the original into Admissions Office.
