Notes:

1. This program is designed to provide the student with updated skills and knowledge necessary to complete and successfully apply for fire service careers. The curriculum serves as an in-service program as well as a pre-employment program for students seeking employment or advancement in the profession of firefighting and technology.
2. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
3. Students should plan to take most of their Associate degree and GE requirements in the Fall semesters.
4. It is recommended that students establish eligibility for ENGL 125 and 126 or EMLS 167 and 168.
5. *FIRET 130A carries a value of up to 13 units; however, only 6 units can be applied to the A.S. Degree.
6. **FIRET 135 is the final of three courses required to successfully complete the Paramedic Training Program. The *Associate Degree* requires completion of the major (41 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Associate Degree requirements – basic competencies, physical education/Dance, and lifetime physical and mental wellness – and General Education requirements for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
