Have successfully completed minimum of Public Safety First Aid and CPR (CA Health and Safety Code 1797.182) Possess a valid California driver's license. Provide proof of a clear physical examination including an electrocardiogram printout (EKG). Contact the Fire Academy Coordinator.
