## **NOTES:**

- 1. Students planning to transfer to CSU Fresno in Business Administration should refer to the CSUF Business Administration major sheet for important major and CSU GE planning information.
- 2. This major contains most of the lower division requirements for CSU Fresno's BS degree in Business Administration. It is available, together with required CSU GE courses, in a one-course-per-month format designed for students who have full time day jobs and are interested in an accelerated program leading to transfer to CSU Fresno in Business Administration as well as in a traditional format. - 3. BA 10 and BA 20 transfer to CSU or UC as an elective. All other courses meet Fresno State's lower division major and/or general education requirements. Fresno State's Craig School of Business requires a 2.25 cumulative GPA.
- 4. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
- 5. The Associate Degree requires completion of the major (33 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Associate Degree requirements –basic competencies, physical education/Dance, and lifetime physical and mental wellness –and General Education requirements for a total of 60 semester units minimum with a 2.0 or better GPA
