- Students Transferring from the Police Academy Candidates who have completed the Basic Academy or the Reserve Level 1
  program may request to waive 6 units from the following courses in the Criminology degree program: Criminology 1, 6, 7, 12. To
  process this, candidates must complete a course waiver form and attach a copy of the Certificate from the Police Academy or a
  copy of their transcript. Forms are available in the Social Sciences Division office. The waiver form is then signed by the dean of
  Social Science and by the dean of Admissions and Records.
- 2 The Associate Degree requires completion of the major (31 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Associate Degree requirements basic competencies, physical education/Dance, and lifetime physical and mental wellness and General Education requirements for a total of **60 semesters units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
